

## Champaign man charged in Saturday burglary

CHAMPAIGN – Bond has been set at \$50,000 for a Champaign man arrested in connection with the burglary of a Champaign home.

According to a Champaign police report, a man entered a home in the 3400 block of Timberline Drive through an unlocked garage door at 4:51 a.m. Saturday.

The residents, a 29-year-old woman and a 27-year-old man, reported catching the burglar removing items from the home and attempting to leave with their truck, according to the report.

Police arrested Edward Todd Penzell, 48, who was listed as a homeless resident of Champaign, and took him to the county jail. On Monday, Penzell pleaded innocent to one count of residential burglary, a Class 1 felony. Judge John Kennedy set his next court appearance for Jan. 5.
